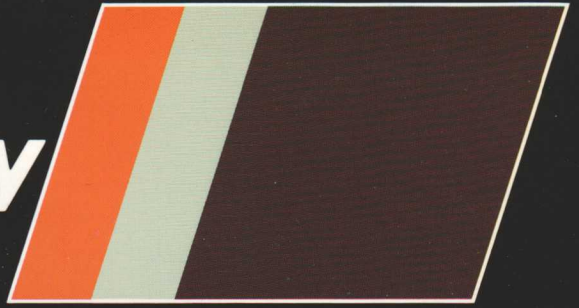

The overall winner of the Shell Oils Open Championship may have been decided in favour of David Llewellyn in his Toyota Celica GT4 before this final round Audi Sport International Rally, but still we have a fascinating battle in store. Not least with the presence of MARKKU ALLEN at the front of the field, the flying Finn commenting at scrutineering in the Ironbridge museum "Yes, we do much testing, but when the numbers go on the doors it is different - necessary - this will be good for RAC. Only when the numbers go on do things go wrong!" When asked if it would be a problem to be driving without the accustomed pace notes, Markku, the winner here in 1982, went on "Not so much, OK it is two years since I do non pace note rally - the RAC - and I won that!" Second team member POSSUM BOURNE has Cardiff's KEN REES on the maps. Ken, winning co driver here 3 years ago, only had a few hours to practice the Antipodean accent, so late was the arrangement made!

Behind Allen its RUSSELL BROOKES & COLIN MCRAE in 2 Gp.A Ford Cosworth 4x4s, with GRAHAM MIDDLETON next up in a 'showroom' example. Brookes, always very quick in these Welsh forests, has been doing extensive forest testing, playing about with diff settings & suspension. The Manx Rally winner has also been having intensive physiotherapy on a damaged shoulder - a sort of golfer's wrist but a bit further up! Its learning curve time for McRae and Middleton in the 4x4s..Middleton's hired machine newly converted from 2 wheel drive, Colin's Pirelli shod car just out of the RED box. Cars 5 and 6 - Cullen & Eriksson non start. At 7 we have the flying Vauxhall Nova of DAVE METCALFE, the same car he used on the Ulster but fitted with a Swedish engine. ANDREW WOOD runs at 8, the Scotsman in with a chance of taking the Shell Oils series Gp.N title. Only a category win will do for Wood, otherwise Gwyndaf Evans stays on top. The Welshman by the way finished 12th overall and 2nd in gp.N this week on the San Remo Rally, despite a 3 minute puncture.

Back here to the Audi Sport...and Peugeot interests are headed by PAUL FRANKLAND in the 205 GTI at No.9, the 25 year old Darlington man anxious to put the final seal on the C'ship class. Its another Peugeot breathing down his neck in the points battle..JEREMY BARNES' private Camden Hardchrome car just 4 pts. behind. The top 10 is rounded off by PAUL DYAS in his Sierra..TERRY KABY at 11 heads a 4 car Charade team here on the Audi. ROBBIE HEAD is at 12 in the brilliant little gp.N Honda Civic V.Tec, the young Lanark man telling us "We've changed the electronics a little, to increase the revs from 8300 to 9000. It will suit the gearbox better and with the class in the C'ship tied up, I'll be able to give it everything!" The Beveridge's are missing from 17, otherwise the top 20 is as programme with the numbers running up to 90.

AUDI SPORT SOCIAL SCENE...TIM FREEMAN, a volunteer fireman but helping out in the Audi Sport Rally press office took a step up the romantic ladder this weekend by going down on bended knee and asking for the hand in marriage of Audi press lady NICKI WRIGHT..even went into Telford and bought the ring! CONGRATULATIONS!

JIM BOTHWELL in the Toyota looks like he has an over heating problem - the Celica, not Jim... while PETER DOUGHTY bounced up a bank in car No.15 but got away with it...

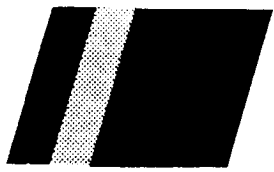
After a couple of time consuming spins on the long Hafren stage of this Audi Sport Rally RUSSELL BROOKES kept the black Sapphire Cosworth on the straight and narrow through stage 2 to set equal fastest time with MARKKU ALEN - both on 11.39 - with COLIN MCRAE next to stop the clock on 11.44. All the drivers report slipper mud on the stages causing countless "moments", but thankfully so far no reports of anyone slipping off the road permanently. COLIN MCRAE was telling us earlier that his new 4 wheel drive Cosworth was really only finished on the run up to the rally, and he had no chance at all to do any testing, so to be right up there in 3rd place after only 2 stages is quite an achievement, the runner up in this Shell Oils C'ship, Colin cannot improve on his Championship position.

By the way, DAVID LLEWELLIN, the winner of the Shell Oils title of course, has been confined to bed for the weekend after coming back from San Remo with bowel infection...Audi supremo STEVE BAGNALL has just been talking to him on the phone...and says David is having a great conversation with the other phone - the big white one!

Back to the rally and our earlier story on TERRY KABY - its been confirmed that the penalty at the start was 6 mins. and he was also 1 min. slower than his closest series class rival TERRY CREE on special stage 1 - the underfinanced Terry Cree in the Vauxhall Astra could just be heading for a big result here today.

Earlier we reported KJELL OLOFSSON up into 4th place after the first stage - we mistakenly said in an Opel Corsa when in fact its one of the little Nissan Turbos. KJELL is a close friend of Per Eklund's back in Sweden - Per rating him highly and in fact he won his class in the Swedish C'ship this year. GERT BLOMQUIST who is the Swede in the Corsa - the green one - with the catalytic converter - recorded a time of 24.47 through Hafren, a full 3 mins. slower than his fellow countryman.

POSSUM BOURNE, with KEN REES on the maps, set 4th fastest time on stage 2...so the New Zealander would appear to have got over his first stage kerfuffle with a bridge parapet OK...more news later..BRIAN & LIZ PATTERSON

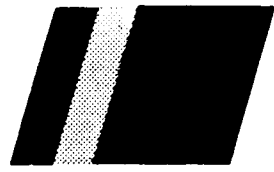
COLIN MCRAE in the Pirelli shod Sierra went better on stage 4 "The roads are drying out a bit now and we were able to have a go"..from Colin...who went on to say that the earlier misfire has improved since the mechanics swapped the electrics about.

In the group N battle ANDREW WOOD is having a real struggle for grip in the 2 wheel drive Cosworth "We can watch Middleton taking seconds off us at every stage start" from Andrew...whose cause has been helped a little with Middleton's puncture on stage 3, a flattened exhaust and resultant lack of power not helping last year's British National Champion either. Andrew however is also going to have to keep an eye out for the flying GEOFF JONES behind - rapidly getting to grips with the 4 wheel drive Galant and hovering right on Andrew's pace. PAUL DYAS is another to speed up in his new car - he's turned the boost up now and getting on the pace, while ROBBIE HEAD reports a severe lack of grip hampering the little Honda on stage 3...POSSUM BOURNE in the 2nd of the Legacys tells us "Ah well mate it just pisses you off - I should have stopped when I got that puncture on the first stage instead of driving for 5 miles on it. Tell you what, its a bit hairy over here in these forests" from the New Zealander.

JIM BOTHWELL has turned the turbo boost down on his Toyota which seems to have counteracted the earlier overheating problme. PAUL FRANKLAND in the Peugeot, comfortably leading his class now from JONNY MILNER by a minute and a half - Paul got a front wheel puncture on stage 4 which cost him little time. OOPS..OLOFSSON HAS JUST ARRIVED INTO SERVICE, so he could split the 2 Peugeots - more news later

 Robbie Head 1.06.46..Possum Bourne 1.07.46..and
 Jonny Milner whose times we haven't got yet...
 After replacing the steering rack plus the pump that
 powers it MARKKU ALEN left Dolgellau and went into
 stage 5 Pantperthog, to take 22 secs. off the pursuing
 RUSSELL BROOKES - another 5 secs. on stage 6 would seem
 to indicate that the flying Finn has the upper hand
 on this Audi Sport Int. Rally....mind you Brookess
 was hampered by a spin on that stage 5, the black
 Sierra getting wedged between a couple of log piles
 in the process. At least Russell got away with it -
 PAUL DYAS didn't - his new 4 wheel drive Cosworth
 completely off the road half a mile into that stage -
 we think with no major damage to car or crew but the
 Ford is well off the road. COLIN MCRAE Is gradually
 becoming more accustomed to his new 4x4...and is
 hanging in there just fractionally off Russell's pace.

ROBBIE HEAD in the Honda Civic reports no dramas and
 is lying on the edge of the leaderboard - the Asquith
 mechanics doing routine service and bleeding the brakes
 here at service - "Yes, the rear brakes get a bit hot -
 over 500 degrees - and the fluid boils - its the left
 foot braking really" from young Robbie...who went on
 and gave a little laugh..."I've knocked the passenger
 mirror off again..fed up with Campbell admiring himself
 in it!"....GRAHAM MIDDLETON was having his exhaust
 welded up again, having flattened it earlier..
 KEVIN FURBER in the Peugeot lost 4 min. with a puncture.
 RICHARD BURNS now leads the Peugeot Cup from RICHARD
 EVANS while TONY CLEMENTS leads the Super Cup...
 JEREMY BARNES in the Camden Hardchrome Peugeot slowed
 right down on stage 3 after SEAMUS CAREY buried his
 Nova in a big hole in the road..TERRY CREE in the
 Vauxhall Astra punctured twice in stage 4...POSSUM
 BOURNE Had another puncture on stage 5 - as he was
 going off the road the New Zealander told co driver
 KEN REES "I think the differential's gone"- got back
 on to the track and reached the end of the stage with
 a very quick time...Rees can't believe this man!!

ROBERT PUGH in the Vauxhall Nova is leading his class
 by 3½ mins. from SIMON CHAPMAN - Pugh had a small
 brake problem on the 1st stage but everything has been
 OK since...co driver JOHN MORRIS reckons that if
 Seamus Carey has gone out Chapman is going to take
 the class in the Shell British C'ship.

"You get me flight back to Helsinki tonight?" was one of the first things MARKKU ALLEN asked the service crew when his Legacy ground to a halt on special stage 7 of this Audi Int. Rally.....Markku and co driver Ilka Kivimaki had been going like a train, increasing their lead over Russell Brookes when with no prior warning the car made a funny noise and just stopped...it looks like a repeat of an earlier problem surrounding the clutch and gearbox input shaft. The Prodrive team was trying a new type of clutch here today, but obviously there is still some small problem.

Suddenly then the spotlight well and truly switches to the battle between BROOKES & MCRAE...the leaderboard above is after stage 7, and then on stage 8 Russell had puncture on the rear right hand wheel and had to drive 7 miles on the flat, losing perhaps half a minute to COLIN MCRAE's Pirelli shod machine. Brookes had the rear brake caliper replaced here at service, and was slightly late clocking out - but of course that's unpenalised. As for McRae ..he reports no real problems, still getting used to the new car, and still feels that the engine could be a little sharper..The gap between the 2 cars is now 10secs. with the long Dyfnant stage and then the blast round Telford Town Park still to come...could this Audi Sport Rally be decided once again at the last gasp?

In group N the pendulum is swinging away from ANDREW WOOD's Shell Oils C'ship chances, the Scotsman slowed on stages 7 and 8 with wayward rear suspension - he actually thought it was a puncture - Andrew has to score maximum gp.N points here today to overcome Gwyndaf Evans' tally after the Ulster Rally.

In the small gp.N category BRIAN WIGGINS in the VAuxhall Astra leads from the similar car of TERRY CREE with just seconds between them, Cree of course keeping a careful eye on the severely off song Charade of TERRY KASY, the Towcester driver still capable of depriving Cree of the 2 litre gp.N category.

POSSUM BOURNE has now crept back on to the leaderboard. The Legacy man not used to driving a left hand drive car..."Once I get used to this I'll be able to go really quick" from the wild New Zealander and co driver KEN REES just shook his head and laughed..it was interesting at service here in the forest to see the wheels and tyres meant for Alen sitting snug in their red tyre warmers'.

I just kept the Pirelli forest tyres on here in the park for the tarmac, in case I slid on to the grass"...For GRAHAM MIDDLETON group N honours as well as 3rd overall today - it looks like Gwyndaf Evans wins gp.N in the Shell British C'ship to join his fellow countryman David Llewellyn in the major awards. Llewellyn of course clinched the whole thing in his Toyota back in the summer.
 PAUL FRANKLAND Is another to tie up his class in the series with that very fine 4th overall today..
 No further word on POSSUM BOURNE - it looks as if he is out of the event...to leave Geoff Jones 5th, Wood 6th Olofsson 7th Bothwell 8th Milner 9th and Robbie Head 10th at the end of this Audi Sport Int. Rally.
