James admitted that his best chance of winning the title on the final round was to cling to the small hope that Rowlands might make a mistake and go off.

That mistake never came, and James was very gracious in defeat. James and co-driver Andrew Hebron will be back next year – hopefully going one better! Good luck to both Ieuan and James for next season. Rowland's wins a free entry on all rounds of the National A championship for next season as his prize.

Poor Alistair Adams. The Bewdley man was flying on the early stages, despite not being convinced that all was going that well. Alistair maintained his pace throughout the day, but retired on the penultimate stage of the rally. It was a sad end to an excellent year, and Alistair was still leading the series going into the final round as well.

Once again the battle for 1600cc honours was one of the features of the day. With Ieuan Rowlands performing miracles at the front of the field, it was left to Ian McCulloch and Iain Shirlaw to do battle in their respective Toyota Corolla and Proton Satria Kit Car. McCulloch was in fine form, pushing as hard as he could to take third in class on the event.

Ian was rewarded for his commitment to the championship this season with the Kumho Man of the Meeting award for his achievements. With one of the smallest budgets, Ian was clearly delighted at winning four free Kumho Tyres. Well-done Ian!

Iain Shirlaw wasn't having the greatest of days in his Proton. A persistent gearbox problem throughout the day left the Motorsport Direct proprietor a little deflated. A spin on one stage didn't help matters either, but the Barnoldswick based driver struggled to the finish with the gearbox literally destroying itself as the team put the car on the trailer. Iain retained his Top 5 position in the championship after an enjoyable season. John Rowlands also performed well on his home stages on the event, as he took a well-earned second in class – behind younger brother Ieuan.

Those not enjoying such great fortune on the Bulldog included Junior Champion Joe Price, who had yet another mechanical problem in his Talbot Sunbeam. Steve Magson had been enjoying the early stages in his rear wheel drive Astra. Unfortunately, the SM Autocare backed driver retired with a ball joint failure on the last stage of the event.

Championship front-runner Allan McDowall joined Magson on the sidelines, as the Opel Kadett driver had a day of gearbox problems that ultimately forced him to retire. McDowall hoping to get as many points on the board as possible after dropping down the order after a puncture strewn Park Systems Rally.

Steve Finch also made a rare appearance on the championship at the Bulldog. The Ford Escort driver taking a season best third overall. Sean Bannister also having a good day in his Peugeot 306.

Holding up the final third of the field with honour was the battle for the smallest class on the rally. Rob Belcher survived two minutes worth of road penalties to take his fourth consecutive class win of the season, edging out familiar class rival Huw Littler-Jones once again in the usual Mini vs. Skoda battle.
